Community Health Nurse Job Description

The Local CHAP Coordinator works with the Local Lead Organization and the Regional Manager to facilitate the successful operation of CHAP.

Key Responsibilities

- Assist in the development and delivery of volunteer peer health educator training sessions and refresher sessions.
- Be available on-call during the CHAP sessions to respond to volunteer peer health educator questions and address urgent cases that require reassessment.
- Interact with health care providers on urgent participant needs as required.
- Attend the Volunteer Peer Health Educator volunteer appreciation.

Qualifications

- Nurse, registered with the provincial College of Nurses, with a community health nursing certificate an asset
- Expertise in community health nursing
- Knowledge of cardiovascular health issues
- Previous experience conducting health education with lay groups
- Previous experience working with volunteers (particularly seniors) an asset
- Strong interpersonal and organizational skills
- Drivers license and reliable vehicle required
