CHAP Abstract Submissions and Presentations

When developing the materials for abstracts and presentations, Local Lead Organizations participating in CHAP are encouraged to work with the CHAP Principal Investigators, Dr Chambers, Dr Kaczorowski or Dr Dolovich. This will ensure that a standardized message is given to all audiences in addition to the specific experiences of the presenting organization.
